Animal Welfare Commitment

As a leading fashion retailer, Nordstrom is committed to delivering the best possible service and merchandise for our customers by sourcing products responsibly. This includes respecting animal welfare when sourcing our products.

To meet that commitment, Nordstrom does not carry products made with animal fur or materials from endangered or vulnerable animals in its Nordstrom, Nordstrom Rack and Last Chance stores or on Nordstrom.com and NordstromRack.com.

Our commitment is in alignment with the Fur Free Alliance's guidelines, which do not permit the use of fur from animals killed solely for their fur, including (but not limited to): mink, fox, lynx, chinchilla, rabbit, coyote, astrakhan/karakul lamb, kangaroo and racoon dog.

Our commitment also does not permit the use of exotic animal skins or other materials from vulnerable, threatened or endangered species, as defined by the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) and the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) Red List.

We will carry products featuring synthetic materials intended to look like fur that are derived from non-animal sources (faux fur) and products that contain:

- materials that are the byproduct of the meat/agriculture/livestock industries (e.g. sheepskin and cowhide);
- non-exotic animal skins converted into leather or that have hair, fleece or fur removed in processing;
- hair attached to animal skin from a pelt typically used as leather (e.g. shearling and calf hair);
- materials clipped, shorn or combed from animals (e.g. alpaca, cashmere and wool that is not from mulesed sheep); or
- feathers or down that are not sourced through live plucking.
