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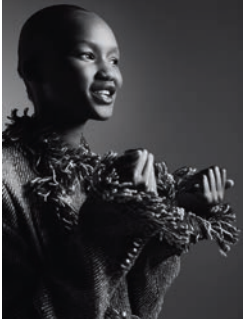

And it's obvious why these clothes are the most crave-worthy, on reflection. Who else would create a blazer with hidden elastic so you can push your sleeves up without a second thought!? Thank you, **SA SU PHI**!

Welcome to The Edit, Nordstrom's newest designer collective.

And who am I, you ask? I'm Becky and it's so great to meet you. I'm a stylist and writer (maybe you've seen my newsletter [5 Things You Should Buy](#)) living in New York. I'm also a mom, an entrepreneur and a lover of getting dressed, in no particular order.

Nordstrom asked if I would test-drive this program (heck yeah!) and after spending weeks both wearing and ruminating over these clothes, I've found this selection more meaningful than I could have imagined. Of course a woman designed taffeta pants with embellishment down the legs that actually make my limbs look longer—you're a genius, Daniella **Kallmeyer**! And one probably wouldn't think a white column dress with voluminous plume at the hips could actually be flattering, but **Loulou de Saison** figured out just exactly where to place those floating feathers to create an optical illusion.

All of these clothes feel fun and filled with style, but not intimidating to put on or difficult to mix and match. Alissa Zachary's red and white railroad striped **High Sport** pants are a shockingly easy pattern to mix with other graphics. **Róhe**'s chameleon-like wide-wale corduroy in brick red transforms from a neutral trouser when worn with bright red and sea green (pictured) to a vibrant statement when paired back to a grey or black knit.
